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The Research and Development Cell (RDC)

S. Chandra Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Amgaon operates with a strong academic foundation, driven by a highly qualified and research-oriented teaching faculty. Following the mandates of NEP 2020 issued by RTMNU, Nagpur, the cell transitions undergraduate education from passive classroom learning to active, experiential problem-solving.

Academic Excellence & Faculty Research Focus

The institution prides itself on the continuous academic advancement of its educators, who actively contribute to global research repositories:

Doctoral Credentials: Out of the college's 13 permanent faculty members, 09 have successfully earned their Ph.D. degrees. The remaining 4 faculty members are formally registered and actively pursuing their doctoral research programs under recognized university supervisors.

Research Publications: The entire teaching faculty regularly writes and publishes peer-reviewed research papers in high-impact national and international journals, actively presenting their findings at UGC-care-listed conferences and academic seminars.

Intellectual Property & Innovation: Highlighting the institution's drive for technological and administrative innovation, the college librarian, Dr. Kamlesh R. Patil, has successfully secured 02 patents to his academic credit.

Research and Consultancy Projects

The college leverages its unique geographical location in a rural and tribal belt to drive localized research frameworks:

Nutritional Consultancy: The Department of Home Sciences operates local consultancy initiatives. Faculties provide diet counselling, metabolic lifestyle planning, and food safety evaluation templates to local communities and self-help groups (Bachat Gats).

Industry & Institutional Collaborations

To bridge the gap between academic theory and practical work environments, the college maintains ten strategic partnerships:

Industrial Internships: Maintains a signed MoU with Hojtex Socks Company, Amgaon, and Shikha's Bakery, Amgaon, giving students direct textile manufacturing and commercial baking field exposure.

Incubation Centre, Start-ups, & Entrepreneurship Cell

The college places a heavy emphasis on turning students from job seekers into job creators:

Incubation Support: Facilitated through a landmark MoU with the Incubein Foundation, Nagpur, providing mentorship, business plan modeling, and guidance on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR).

Skill-to-Enterprise Pipelines: Utilizing training from partnerships with modern educational hubs like Euro Kids Convent and technical centers like Shri Sai Krupa CSE Centre, students are incubated to launch localized preschool facilities or digital service hubs.

Central Research & Academic Facilities

The RDC cell coordinates and updates centralized institutional facilities to ensure student research readiness:

Centralized Science Labs: Fully equipped testing labs supporting chemistry, household biology, and textile analysis.

The Learning Resource Centre: Houses over 1,524 reference manuals, 9 national/international journals, and coordinates digital portals for the National Digital Library of India (NDLI).

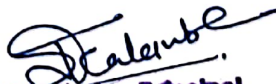
Geographic & Computing Labs: Features dedicated survey equipment, mapping tables, and computer configurations to build data analytic skills.

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
