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STATUTORY CHARTER: ANTI-RAGGING CELL

1. Regulatory Mandate & Zero-Tolerance Policy Statement

In strict compliance with the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 (under Section 26(1)(g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956) and the statutory provisions of the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999, **S. Chandra Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Amgaon** enforces a strict Zero-Tolerance Policy toward ragging in any form on the institution's campus.

Ragging is classified as a primitive, highly undignified, and strictly punishable criminal offense. Any act—whether physical, verbal, mental, or written—that causes or is likely to cause physical harm, psychological trauma, fear, embarrassment, or academic disruption to a newly enrolled student will be met with immediate administrative expulsion and direct criminal prosecution under the law.

Core Objectives and Functions

The Anti-Ragging Cell and its active monitoring unit, the Anti-Ragging Squad, operate continuously with the following administrative responsibilities:

Prohibition & Safe Vigilance: Conducting surprise inspection sweeps across campus, common rooms, the library reading hall, practical science laboratories, and campus borders to prevent any interaction gaps.

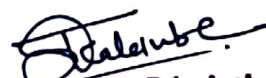
Rigorous Grievance Redressal: Undertaking time-bound, transparent, and strict investigative inquiries into any reported incidents of ragging, independent of external variables.

Orientation Camps: Arranging legal literacy workshops at the start of each semester to educate incoming students on reporting mechanisms and security safeguards.

Anti-Ragging Committee Composition

To protect complete administrative transparency, safety, and unbiased evaluation, the committee brings together senior faculty members, non-teaching office managers, local police authorities, and civil society representatives:

Punitive Penalties and Administrative Action Routing

Any student found guilty of organizing, executing, or abetting ragging on campus will face one or more of the following statutory penalties, routed through the College Development Committee (CDC):

Immediate Suspension: Suspension from attending regular academic lectures and accessing practical laboratories.

Withholding of Credentials: Withholding or cancelling scholarships, fee concessions, results, or official RTMNU university exam hall tickets.

Institutional Expulsion: Permanent debarment and expulsion from the college, accompanied by an explicit adverse entry on the student's Transfer Certificate (TC).

Legal & Criminal Prosecution: Registration of a formal First Information Report (FIR) with the Amgaon Police Station for criminal processing under the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 (which carries penalties of rigorous imprisonment for up to two years and financial fines).

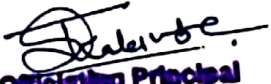
