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STATUTORY CHARTER: FACILITIES FOR THE DIFFERENTLY-ABLED (DIVYANGJAN)

1. Regulatory Mandate & Policy Statement

In strict compliance with **The Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016** and the explicit administrative mandates issued by the **University Grants Commission (UGC)** for Higher Educational Institutions, **S. Chandra Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Amgaon** enforces a comprehensive **Equal Access and Barrier-Free Policy**.

The college is dedicated to providing an inclusive architectural and pedagogical ecosystem. It ensures that no student is denied higher education or restricted from active campus participation due to temporary or permanent physical, sensory, or neurological challenges.

Core Provisions & Barrier-Free Infrastructure

The institutional infrastructure is systematically audited by the *College Development Committee (CDC)* to maintain continuous structural access:

Physical and Architectural Infrastructure

- **Tactile and Anti-Skid Ramps:** Built at primary architectural entry and exit points across the campus blocks to allow seamless mobility and independent access.
- **Handrails and Support Grips:** Installed along all primary ramps and structural staircases to assist students with locomotor challenges.
- **Ground-Floor Academic Mapping:** To eliminate vertical transit hurdles, students with severe physical or locomotor disabilities receive prioritized ground-floor seating for regular classroom lectures, internal examinations, and practical laboratory slots.

Learning Resources & Pedagogical Accommodations

- **Bilingual Audio Assistance:** Staff members provide localized dictation support and audio configurations for critical study blocks upon request.

- **Modified Examination Seating:** Front-row or ground-floor seating grids are automatically allocated to differently-abled candidates during all continuous internal evaluations (CIE) and university exams.

Statutory Scribe & Examination Provisions

The college operates strict, university-compliant support mechanisms for students requiring written assistance during semester assessments:

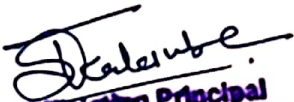
- **Authorized Scribe Allocation:** In strict accordance with the **RTMNU University Examination Ordinances**, the college coordinates the formal appointment of verified scribes/writers for eligible students.
- **Compensatory Exam Time:** Differently-abled candidates using scribes are granted a mandatory **extra time allowance of 20 minutes per hour** (or as revised by university guidelines) to complete their written examination papers.
